Water Quality Report

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources regulates our water system and requires us to test the water on a regular basis. The City of Duenweg is proud to report that we are compliant with all regulations and meets all safe water standards. A copy of this year's water quality report is included on the last pages of this newsletter.

Pet Licenses

It is the time of year when animals seem to get out and roam around town more often. Please make sure that your dog or cat has a City of Duenweg pet tag and that it is renewed each year. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required. They are only \$1.00 each year and help us return your pet to you if they are lost.

News from the Board of Aldermen

The May 2017 Council Meeting was held on May 25, 2017 and the following were discussed:

- Discussion was held regarding new property tax statement software. The Board of Aldermen authorized the purchase of the software for \$4,195.00.
- A new sign and door decals for City Hall to assist with people knowing location and hours were discussed and will be installed soon. An addition of an awning will be discussed at a later date.
- Beacon GIS expenses were discussed. More information is needed before a decision is made.
- Liability insurance for the next year, June 5, 2017-June 5, 2018 was discussed and approved. The insurance also included terrorism insurance for the City of Duenweg.
- Bill NO 2017-001. An ordinance to fix a business license fee on any person/person or company or corporation within the corporate limits of the City Of Duenweg, Jasper County, MO was read and adopted on its final reading.
- Bill NO 2017-002 A ordinance to supplement the personal insurance after an employee suffers a catastrophic health episode for the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, MO was presented by Mayor Olds to the Board of Aldermen in draft form. Discussion held, no formal reading at this time.
- Jeff Littrell was present to ask the City of Duenweg to vacate their interest in the property he purchased on Brookside. The Board of Aldermen voted to approve this request.
- The City of Duenweg has an ordinance to regulate infrastructure being added to the city by other utility companies. The Board of Aldermen approved the infrastructure permit for the work being done by AT&T on South Prigmor.
- Box culverts are being purchased to be installed near the intersection of Rogers and Irwin. Be aware of Irwin street closures as that work is being done.

The June meeting is on June 22, 2017 at 7:00 pm. JANUARY 6, 1954

- Wear sunscreen before heading outdoors and reapply often.
- Wear sunglasses, hats, and cool, light clothing for extra sun protection.

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

Past Due Notices City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.
