

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PUTTING OUT AND RETRIEVING OF TRASH RECEPTACLES IN THE CITY OF DUENWEG, JASPER COUNTY, MISSOURI.**

**WHEREAS**, trash carts when left curbside are an obstruction to traffic and an eyesore in the City of Duenweg.

**WHEREAS**, the city of Duenweg desires to maintain a clean streets policy and ensure that traffic is not impeded by trash carts left curbside beyond the collection day.

**WHEREAS**, the city of Duenweg seeks to protect public health and safety by ensuring trash carts are properly removed from the curb after collection

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri as follows:

**SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS**

- A. Receptacle – any object used for the collection of trash, including but not limited to carts, cans, and or bins.

**SECTION 2. TRASH CART PICKUP AND REMOVAL**

- A. Trash carts are to be placed at the curb the day/evening before the scheduled pickup by the trash company.
- B. Trash carts are to be removed from the curb to another location, away from the street within 24 hours of collection.

**SECTION 3. PENALTIES**

- A. Failure to recover or remove said cart within the 24-hour period, is subject to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

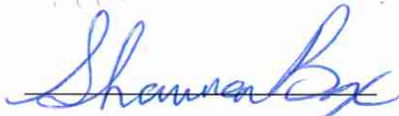
B. Fines will accrue at twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day for every day after the warning was issued.
