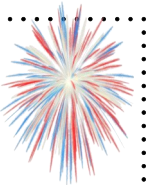

BILL NO 2020-008

ORDINANCE NO 2020-008

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITH IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DUENWEG, JASPER COUNTY, MISSOURI, AND REPEAL



Exerts from Ordinance No 2020-008 is as follows:

Section IV: The discharge of fireworks within the City of Duenweg shall be limited to the hours of 9 A.M. and 10 P.M., except on July 4th discharge shall be until 12 A.M. (Midnight), starting on June 25th and extending to July 10th. The discharge of fireworks within the City of Duenweg shall be limited to the hours of 11:30 P.M. December 31st through 1 A.M. January 1st. No fireworks may be fired or discharged except on one's own property or on the property of another with the permission of the property owner. Fireworks shall not be discharged on City property without a special permit. No person shall discharge any fireworks in such a manner as to threaten or to injure another person or property.

SECTION VIII: It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly allow a minor to discharge any fireworks except caps or cap pistols other than during times and dates listed in Section IV.

With the 4th of July holiday approaching, here is a reminder in advance of the city ordinance regarding fireworks. Also be aware that the City Hall will be closed on the 5th of July in observance of the holiday. Thank you and have a great holiday.



News From The...

Board of Aldermen...

The June 2021 Council Meeting that was to be held on June 24, 2021, with discussions as follows:

- Mayor Pro-Tem William Haldeman was nominated and elected for another term to expire in 2022.
- The following checks were ratified as follows:
 - ◊ Mid America Rebuilders to repair a patrol vehicle.
 - ◊ TEC for security cameras.
 - ◊ The Board of Aldermen authorized Mayor Olds to sign the check to Fry & Associates, Inc. as the expenditure was authorized by the Duenweg Park Board for park equipment.
 - ◊ The purchase of jeans for the Public Works Department from Cintas.
- Audit for 2020 was discussed.
- Bill NO. 2021-012 was accepted and adopted on it's first and second reading respectively to authorize and approve the selling of 307 Irwin to MFH, LLC.
- Resolution NO. 2021-014 was adopted as a resolution for the 2021 Jasper-Newton Bi-County Hazard Mitigation Plan of Intent to participate in natural hazard mitigation and to work toward becoming a safer community by the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri.
- Bill NO. 2021-017 was accepted and adopted on it's first and second reading respectively, to approve the re-plat of Southwind Trail, Phase I, final plat by the Board of Aldermen.
- Bill NO. 2021-011 was accepted on its first reading for the election of a city clerk for the City of Duenweg for the term of August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022.
- The Board of Aldermen authorized the purchase of more fire hydrant locks to secure our water system within and outside the City of Duenweg.
- There were various discussions on upcoming projects within the city limits of Duenweg.

IF YOU USE PAYPAL

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

Meeting Times & Schedules

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

With storm season upon us I wanted to take a moment to inform every one of the cities policies on warning sirens. Our sirens are for outdoor warning. If you are indoors you need to rely on television or a NOAA weather radio. The sirens will sound when a tornado warning is received for our portion of our county or surrounding counties or when winds speeds reach 70 MPH or higher. We will not issue an all clear.

The city residents have access to the storm shelter owned by the Joplin School District, located at 801 S Irwin. The fire station is not a shelter. If you go to the fire station you will be sent to the shelter at the school. The shelter will be opened when severe weather approaches our area. The school district has a policy that any animal in the shelter must be in a cage or carrier. This is for everyone's safety. If you have any questions or concerns please let us know. Let's all work together to make this a safe season for all.
