Severe Weather Season is here again...

...so please take note the storm sirens are for outdoor notification and are not intended to notify you while you are inside your home or any structure. Please monitor news stations, radio stations, and your weather radios about approaching storms or during current weather events. If thunderstorms are approaching, please take the proper steps to take shelter and preparation to protect yourself and your family. Remember, the Community **Storm Shelter is located at 801 S Irwin St.** and will be open when a Tornado Warning is issued for our area. Please note Joplin School District has set rules that have to be followed for the use of the storm shelters. If you have any pets that need to seek shelter they will need to be in a pet carrier and in control of the owner.

If you have a storm shelter at your home, please take the time to get it flagged with the Fire Department. Come by the Duenweg Fire Station and fill out a location sheet so your shelter will be added to the system at the dispatch center in case of an emergency you and your family will be found right away.

Please make sure your Premises Identification (house numbers) are on your house so they can be seen clearly from the street and they are towards the front of the property. They must contrast with their background on your homes so they can be seen. They must be of Arabic numbers and letters; they shall be a minimum of 4 inches tall with the minimum width of the letter being 0.5 inches wide.

Board of Aldermen...

The April 2021 Council Meeting was held on April 22, 2021 and the following were discussed:

- The Board of Alderman accepted the Election results for April 6, 2021.
- Max Murray, WCA, was present to discuss the trash contract of which was accepted by the Board of Aldermen to continue with this company for another five years.
- Bill NO. 2021-007, was adopted regarding the sale of property to MFH, LLC.
- Bill NO. 2021-008, was adopted regarding the sale of property to MFH, LLC.
- Bill No. 2021-009, was adopted regarding the purchase of property by the City of Duenweg.
- A sealed bid was opened and accepted by the Board of Aldermen to clean up the property at 301 Irwin Street.
- Public Works, Ron Klein, requested the following purchases: storm water boxes, approved for \$1,430.00 and \$830.00; mower purchase, approved for \$13,000.00; Pomp's invoice ratified for \$2,174.44; safety cage purchase, approved for \$2,075.00; 7th Street Water bore that was previously approved for \$15,000.00, ratified for \$2,568.72 overage; water line extension, ratified supplies for \$1,860.87; fire hydrant purchase, approved for \$1,502.55.
- The Board of Aldermen approved the City Clerk to request bids for the city's bank accounts.
- Discussion was held regarding the partnership with ETG and the Duenweg Fairgrounds.

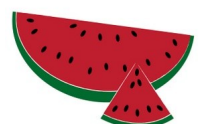
Park Board...

Trash Pick-Up Dates —

Trash Day is Wednesday. If there is a holiday on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday, then Trash Day is still on Wednesday. If the holiday is on Wednesday then the trash day will be on Thursday. If you have any questions, please call 417-623-6620.

IF YOU USE PAYPAL

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

Meeting Times & Schedules

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.

The Public Works Department would like you to know that if you have issues with City Utilities after hours, please call 417-623-2263 so the proper authorities can be notified.

Tree Limb Pickup

If there are storms that cause tree damage the Public Works department will pick up any downed limbs if they are put at the curb. They work their way through town as they have time to do so.

If you are planning on doing your own yardwork and tree pruning, or trash, you can request that the city dump truck or trailer be brought to your house over the weekend. They will park it at the curb so that you can load it and they will haul it off on Monday. Call City Hall a few days in advance to arrange for this.

Any work done by a hired individual or business has to be removed by the business, they cannot use city equipment or facilities. They also need to have a current business license with City of Duenweg. If you have any questions call City Hall at 417-623-2027.
