News From The...

Board of Aldermen...

The April 2018 Council Meeting was held on April 26, 2018 and the following were discussed:

- Accepted election results from April 3, 2018.
- Nominated and elected Mayor Pro-Tem for a one year term. Aldermen Haldemen nominated and elected for Mayor Pro-Tem.
- Voluntary annexation presented to the Board of Aldermen for 861 S. Prigmor, Duenweg, Missouri.
- Bill NO. 2018-001. An ordinance for pre-payment or pre-approval at establishments that sell gasoline and/or diesel fuel. Bill NO. 2018-001 was held for more investigation and will be discussed next council meeting.
- Resolution NO. 2018-002. A resolution to adopt the police officer's commission oath for the City of Duenweg Police Department for the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri. Resolution NO. 2018-002 was adopted on its first and final reading.
- Pasture Lease Agreement. This agreement is in negotiation and will be brought back to next council meeting.
- Board of Aldermen authorized to purchase request for six licenses for POST training for the police officers.
- The annual Gilmore & Bell Audit Report was presented by City Clerk.
- Animal Shelter discussion.
- Board of Aldermen authorized Dennis Hutson to obtain bids for chemical ground electrode system to surround the water tower.
- Moved into closed meeting.

IF YOU USE PAYPAL

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

Meeting Times & Schedules

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

Past Due Notices City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.
