Board of Aldermen...

The October Council Meeting was held on October 22, 2020 at 7:00 PM, with the following discussed:

- The Board of Aldermen approved the contract with TREKK Design Group, LLC for the new sewer project.
- Curb and gutter bids were accepted for Robin Street from Dollar General to Voegel Street.
- Damien Anderson submitted a project for the Board of Aldermen to review for his Eagle Scout project. Project was accepted and will move forward.
- Bill NO. 2020-012, 2020-013, 2020-014 all accepted on their second and final readings.
- Resolution NO. 2020-016 authorizing the execution of an agreement with the Missouri Office of State Courts Administrator regarding services related to the Justice information system implementation process was adopted on its first and final reading. As well as Bill NO. 2020-017 authorizing the additional court costs for this program.
- Bill NO. 2020-018 authorizing and approving the contract for sale of property between Duenweg Volunteer Fire Department LLC and the City of Duenweg located within the city limits of the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri.

IF YOU USE PAYPAL

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, **PLEASE** set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

**City Water Bill Payments
are Due Upon Receipt**

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site as a guest using PayPal, calling with a credit card number, or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date, if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied for payments not received by the 20th. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 AM, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee of \$25.00 if your water is turned off for non-payment.

DVFD Helpful Holiday Hints!

- * Keep outdoor fryers off decks, out of garages, and a safe distance away from trees and other structures.
- * Make sure the turkey is thawed and dry before cooking. Ice or water that mixes into the hot oil can cause flare-ups.
- * Place the fryer on a level surface, and keep children and pets away!
