News From The...

Board of Aldermen...

The August Council Meeting was held on September 24th, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., with the following discussed:

- Public Hearing held for properties where the owner(s) wish to voluntary annex into the City of Duenweg.
- Bill NO. 2020-011 was adopted on its third and final reading. Bill NO. 2020-011 is an ordinance authorizing the City of Duenweg, Missouri to employ an attorney to assist the City of Duenweg, Missouri, in negotiating and closing a loan for the construction and operation of a Water or Wastewater System in the City of Duenweg, Missouri, and such other legal works as may be needed in conjunction with the Construction and initial operation of the facility.
- Bill NO. 2020-012, 2020-013, 2020-014 all accepted on their first readings.
- Accepted the expenditure of \$5,020.00 for a Phase I Cultural Resource Survey to proceed with the new sewer project.
- Discussed and allotted monies to purchase a box blade for the public works department.
- Discussed and approved the expenditure for a 60” used woods mower.

Duenweg Park Board met on September 8th, 2020, and the following was discussed:

- Signs & posts are complete for Apple Park and will be installed at a later date.
- Jeff Routledge has marked some trees that they would like to keep on the land east of Bartley Memorial Park and will get testing done on the soil before beginning work on that area.
- Approved the D-Towne Jamboree & Celebration Day shirts for the 2020 event.
- Getting a quote for a sign on the southwest corner near Apple Park to add new panels that say Apple Park and remove the panel that says sports complex until we begin work behind the school.
- Members agreed to host the 2nd Annual Park Board Trunk or Treat on October 26th from 6 to 8 P.M. next to the Duenweg Volunteer Fire Department.

The next meeting for the Duenweg Park Board will be held on October 13th, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Duenweg Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street, Duenweg, Missouri.

DUENWEG VOLUNTARY FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS!

With the winter coming up very quickly, now is the time to prepare for the winter ahead. If you have a Fireplace, take the time to clean out the chimney/flue; you need to clean out the soot so it will not catch fire. It will also let everything operate properly; this will make sure it is ready for when you start burning. Check out your stove and Firebox. Please make sure they are in good shape. Have an inspection done on your chimney/flue to ensure it is still in good condition, and no cracks or damage can cause a fire. To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, **PLEASE** set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

Meeting Times & Schedules

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site as a guest using PayPal, calling with a credit card number, or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date, if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 a.m., then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee of \$25.00 if your water is turned off for non-payment.
