## *News From The...*

### *Board of Aldermen...*

The August 2018 Council Meeting was held on August 23, 2018 and the following were discussed:

- Board of Aldermen authorized for surveys to be ordered for Elm Street north of Azalea Street and for Robin Street north of Rogers.
- Discussion was held regarding Casey's store and property allowed for their freezer on the south side of the building.
- Jake Vanlue was present to discuss purchasing 1.5 acres m/l of the Prigmor property for storage facilities.
- Resolution 2018-006. A resolution regarding short term disability for city employees was discussed and further investigation is to be conducted.
- Resolution 2018-007. A resolution to adopt complete street policy was discussed. Further investigation is to be conducted before adoption.
- The Board of Aldermen discussed engineering firms for the upcoming SCEAP grant.

The September 2018 council meeting will be on Thursday, September 27, 2018 at 7:00 pm. ### *Fire Department...*

As a reminder your houses need to be numbered correctly with the correct size numbers (height 4" tall, 1/2" wide), and color so that the numbers contrast with their background & can easily be seen from the street. So if there is an emergency, Emergency Responders will be able to find your home quickly.

We will be seeing the weather season start changing coming up very quickly now that we are moving into the fall season so now is the time to prepare for the seasonal changes that are ahead. If you have a fireplace take the time to clean out the flue/chimney to make sure it is ready. Check out your stove and fire box make sure they are in good shape. Have an inspection done on your flue/chimney to make sure it is still in good condition & that there are no cracks or damage that can cause a fire. By doing all these things it will help prevent a fire from happening.

This upcoming fall season if you do decide that you want to have controlled burn of your leaves & yard debris please contact the Duenweg Volunteer Fire Department at 417-623-7408 between 7:30am and 4:30pm 7 days a week and let us know if you are planning on burning please call on the day you plan to do the burning as we will not give the ok to burn on any day other than the current day, this way we can let you know of the current day's weather conditions & if it is a good time to burn or not.

Some of the items you will need to have if burning are a rake, shovel, water hose that reaches your burn pile, make sure you plan on being out with the fire until it is completely out, and have the fire out by dark. We will also need your Name, Phone Number, & Address when you call so please have the information ready when you call.

Things you are **allowed** to burn are leaves, grass, natural wood products.

Things you are **not allowed** to burn are, Couches, Chairs, Laminated woods, Foam, Oils, any Petroleum products, etc.

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

### City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.
