

THE MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING OF THE CITY OF DUENWEG
HELD IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING AT 118 WEBB STREET, ON
OCTOBER 14TH, 2016.

A Public Hearing to discuss and hear public comments concerning the water rates and sewer rates increases for the City of Duenweg was held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street, on October 14th, 2016 at 11:00 a.m.

Notices were posted on September 27th thru October 20th, 2016, at Duenweg City Hall, Duenweg Municipal Building, and Duenweg Post Office, all located in Duenweg, MO, as well as the Webb City Sentinel on September 30th, October 7th, and October 14th, 2016.


The meeting was called to order by Mayor Olds at 11:00 a.m.

Mayor Olds explained the reason for the Public Hearing to those present.

Public Comments:


- Mayor Olds silently read the letter sent by Phyllis Boydston at 508 Irwin, Duenweg, MO. No comment made at this time.
- Mayor Olds stated to those present that he had asked the city council at the September 2016 regular meeting to consider not raising the rates for sewer at the first of the year. Mayor Olds then also stated that if revenues drop we may then have to raise the rates at a later date.
- Diana West asked if we are still on target for building our own treatment plant. Mayor Olds explained that the state agency replied that the sites submitted were not recommended for the land application facility.
- Mayor Olds stated we are still in need of roof tops and flushing toilets.

With no further comments or discussion the public hearing was closed and adjourned at 11:54 a.m. by Mayor Olds.
