Yard Maintenance & Pet Permits

With the arrival of spring, we wanted to send out a few reminders regarding property maintenance and pet permits. There are city ordinances regarding the upkeep of properties and pets inside the City of Duenweg. Our officers will be enforcing these ordinances in an effort to keep our city safe and looking its best. Examples of common things to be mindful of are as follows:



- All dogs and cat owners must obtain a tag for each dog or cat. These are to be renewed each year. Proof of a current rabies vaccination is required.
- Grass and weeds must not exceed 12" on occupied properties and 18" on vacant lots.
- Accumulation of refuse, scrap metal, and other items considered to be a nuisance by ordinance are not permitted.
- Non-operating vehicles may not be left on properties.

Copies of the ordinances related to the above mentioned issues as well as other nuisance and pet related issues can be obtained at City Hall or are located on the website at www.duenwegmo.com. If you notice a non-emergency issue, contact the Duenweg Police Department at 417-623-2263 and speak to an officer or leave a message with their answering service.

The February 2017 Council Meeting was held on February 23, 2017 and the following were discussed:

- Bill NO 2017-001 An ordinance to fix a business license fee on any person/persons or company or corporation within the corporate limits of the City of Duenweg, Jasper County, Missouri.
- Ratify the expenditures of the purchase of a chlorine pump and water pump for the wells.
- Ratify the expenditure for police training.
- Approve the LEST Grant 2017 for the Police Department.
- Coleen Sifferman, 105 Coyle, discussed concerns of the business license ordinance.

City Hall Temporary Location

City Hall is temporarily located at the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street due to remediation and restoration of 106 Webb Street. This will be the location until further notice. The public will be notified when the 106 Webb location is back in use. There is currently not a drop box, payments can be made during business hours from 7:30 am—4:30 pm Monday through Friday, over the phone during business hours with a credit card, or online at any time at duenwegmo.com. The online payment process uses PayPal, but you do not need to have a PayPal account. Please make sure your service address is included.

IF YOU USE PAYPAL

To pay your water, sewer, trash bill with the City of Duenweg, PLEASE set it up for payment by the 14th of the month so it will clear and be posted to the CITY'S account before your bill is past due! We do NOT receive notifications that a payment has been made UNTIL that payment is DEPOSITED into OUR account, therefore, if you pay your bill using PayPal after the 13th of the month, we may not receive notice that you have paid that bill until after we have processed it for late payment! This does NOT affect payments made in person or over the phone using your debit or credit card.

The City of Duenweg Board of Aldermen (Council) meets on the FOURTH Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

The City of Duenweg Park Board meets on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. If you would like to address the Park Board, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 by the Monday before the meeting to be listed on the agenda.

The City of Duenweg Planning Board meets on the THIRD Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. If you would like to be listed on the agenda, please notify City Hall at (417) 623-2027 two business days before the meeting.

All Board Meetings are held in the Municipal Building at 118 Webb Street.

Past Due Notices

City Water Bill Payments are Due Upon Receipt

Bills can be paid online through the City's web site and PayPal or in person at City Hall. Beginning on the 21st of each month, or on the Monday following that date if it falls on a weekend, a late charge of 10% is applied and past due notices are mailed out to those who have not paid their bills by that date. If the past due notices are not paid by the 25th of the same month at 8:00 am, then your water service will be discontinued on the 25th or the next business day if it is on a weekend or holiday. There is a reconnect fee if your water is turned off for non-payment.
